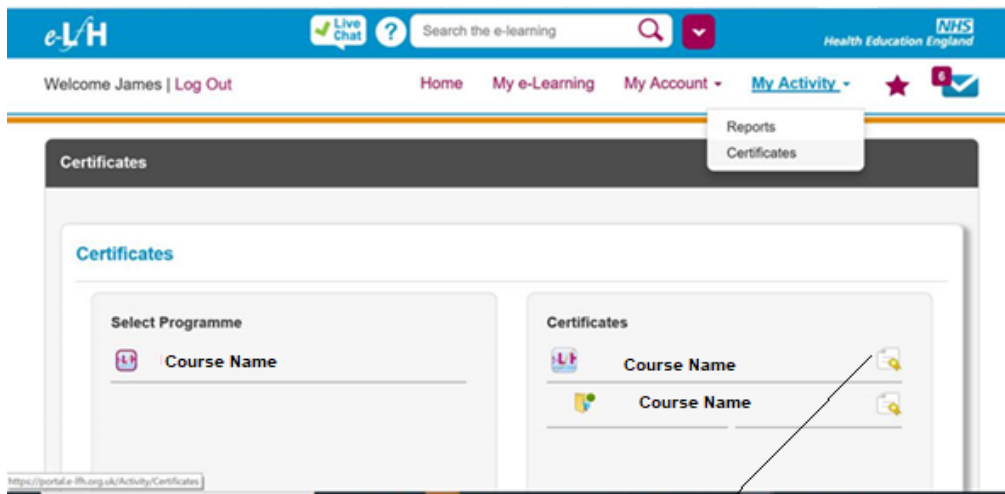


Confirming e-Learning for Health (e-LfH) training

Health professionals who have completed an e-LfH courses should be asked to confirm that they have completed their training through sight of the relevant course certificate. Certificates can be downloaded from e-LfH as follows:

1. Log on
2. Click on my activity
3. Click on Certificates
4. Select the programme that has been completed on the left hand side
5. Select the certificate for that course; the certificate can then be printed or saved.

PCNs may ask staff to physically present their certificates, or may ask for certificates to be electronically sent to a PCN coordinator. Training Hubs may be able to support logging/sign-off processes.
