½ day | Equivalent to 3 CPD points | £120PP

Delivered together with experts from Cruse Bereavement Care, this half-day Maudsley Masterclass will help participants develop skills in supporting bereaved persons. The course will cover some useful and recent models of grief and apply these to understanding and supporting people going through 'normal' and more complicated grieving processes.

[Prescribing psychotropics in physical illness](#)

Psychotropic medications are serious treatments for serious illnesses. Whilst often effective in the medically fit population, they frequently produce disappointing efficacy outcomes in the medically unwell. This course is taught by specialist liaison pharmacists from the Maudsley Pharmacy and will address the safe and effective use of psychotropics in patients with serious physical comorbidities and a range of common mental health conditions.
